General Terms and Conditions

Payment

- AniCura will only accept payment by card.
- No booking will be final and confirmed until the full amount is paid.
- Unless stated differently, fees include lectures, lecture notes (in most cases in digital form to save on the environment) and refreshments during the course. Costs for travel and accommodations are not included.

Cancellation policy

- You may cancel bookings at any time by notifying AniCura at education@anicuragroup.com.
- When cancelling more than 60 calendar days prior to the course, the full course fee will be refunded.
- When cancelling between 30 and 60 calendar days prior to the course, 50% of the course fee will be refunded
- When cancelling between 15 and 30 calendar days prior to the course, 25% of the course fee will be refunded.
